The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

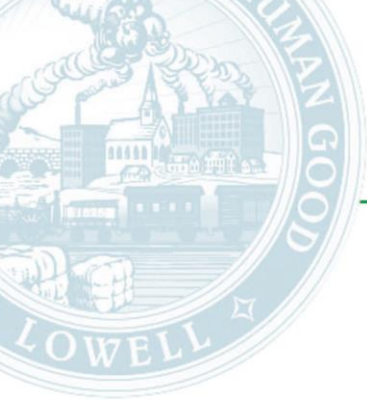
