SUBJECT: PROPOSED 60 DAY TRIAL TRAFFIC ORDERS

Attached is the 60-day trial traffic order for this week as follows:

- One-way street designated – Elmwood Avenue. Per Motion 6/13/2023 - Councilor Robinson - Request City Manager Have Proper Department Evaluate Turning Elmwood Avenue Into A One-Way.  
Elmwood Avenue is located in the Centerville neighborhood and extends between Bridge Street and Hampshire Street. A Motion Response is provided to further explain this trial.
- Parking for handicapped persons – 2 Lewis Street. Per an in-person request from the resident of 2 Lewis Street with a confirmed Disabled Persons Placard. This location is in the Acre neighborhood.
- Loading Zones – Morton Street. Per Petition read and referred to the Transportation Engineer by Council on May 30, 2023. The loading zone is along the first block of Morton Street north of Lawrence Street, accessing the Corner Café at 1164 Lawrence Street. This location is in the South Lowell neighborhood.
