Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period up to sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period up to sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows: Effective immediately for a period of up to sixty (60) days, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

Broadway Street (800)	South	Beginning at a point 280 feet east of the easterly curbline of Wilder Street and running easterly for 20 feet.

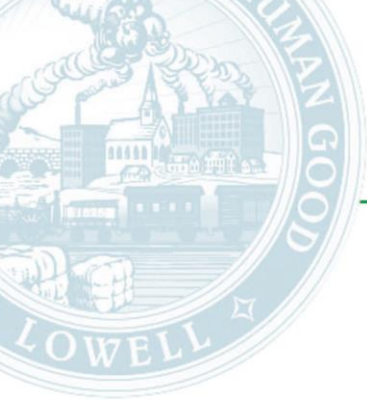

Attached is the 60-day trial traffic order for this week.

This 60-day trial traffic order includes the following items requested by petition from residents.

East Merrimack Street (Lower Belvidere):

- ADD Handicapped Parking Space at 173 East Merrimack Street

Broadway Street (Acre):

- ADD Handicapped Parking Space at 800 Broadway Street

Cedar Street (Back Central):

- REMOVE Handicapped Parking Space at 11 Cedar Street

This 60-day trial includes the following restriction of parking requested by the Department of Public Works to ease refuse pickup:

- No Parking along Bartlett Street at its 90-degree intersection with Alder Street (Belvidere)
