

**IN CITY COUNCIL  
EXECUTIVE SESSION  
MAYOR'S RECEPTION ROOM  
TUESDAY FEBRUARY 21, 2023

Roll Call 11 present.

M. Chau presiding.

Others Present: City Manager Golden, Jr., Conor Baldwin (CFO), City Solicitor Helene Tomlinson, Shawn Machado (Asst. City Mgr.), Alethea Dy (Asst. Solicitor) Melissa Desroches (Manager's Office).

The purpose of the Executive Session was stated by M. Chau in the open session followed by a Roll Call. The public was informed the meeting would adjourn from the Executive Session when concluded.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Manager Golden, Jr. noted request to have a litigation update provide to the Council and Atty. Thomlinson introduced Atty. Dys who provided update. Atty. Dys commented on civil rights cases as follows: Aaron (LPD dismissed); Lessard (LPD dismissed); McGlaughlin (Atty. Fees panhandling 2015 – no action pending for some time); and Rosario (wrongful conviction, outside counsel on board. C. Jenness requested update from that counsel to be provided, no objection to request.

The following tort cases were discussed: Berrios (burial case); Heller (constructive discharge); Jane Doe (school bus case – sexual assault, NRT defending City); Ferrara (student injury); and Perrullo (splash pad injury).

Atty. Dys noted that there were four open cases regarding water main break damage.

The following miscellaneous cases were discussed: Anaya (LPD property); Romoha (LPD discrimination); Grand Manor (post judgement interest); Killela (school sexual discrimination); Lowell Doctor's Park (eminent domain); Lowell Doctor's Park (relocation costs); Meldanado (LPD discrimination); Gayleen (LHS pool case settled); and Khaufoli (school supt. case settled).

Manager Golden, Jr. commented on Race Street water damage due to flooding from water main break. C. Robinson noted need to help displaced family. C. Nuon commented on the family and did not realize claim was pending. M. Chau made note of the family and was not involved after they were represented by an attorney. Manager Golden, Jr. made suggestion that Law Department speak with family, no objections. C. Gitschier noted it was litigation and members must be cautious moving forward.
