
Dear Ms. Bonglo:

The City of Lowell appreciates your years of service as a member of the Lowell Housing Authority, and on its behalf I extend thanks.

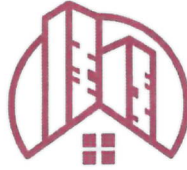
