ORDER

Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period of sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of sixty (60) days thereafter, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

§266-55

Parking for handicapped persons; elderly drop-off zones- C is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Lincoln Street (332)	North	Beginning at a point 160 feet west of the westerly curblineline of Autumn Street and running westerly for 20 feet.

Moody (517) North Beginning at a point 131 feet east of the easterly curblineline of James Street and running easterly for 20 feet.

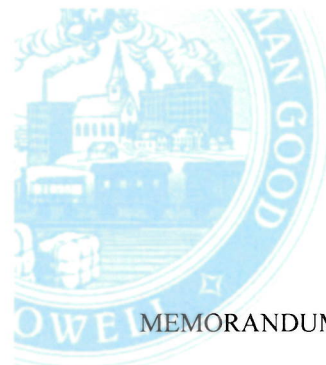
Williams Street (100) South Beginning at a point 20 feet west of the westerly curblineline of George Street and continuing westerly a distance of 40 feet.

§266-98 **Two hour parking meter zones** – is hereby amended by **adding** the following

Name of Street	Side	Location
Williams Street	South	From George Street westerly to a point 200 feet west of George Central Street

§266-98 **Two hour parking meter zones** – is hereby amended by **deleting** the following

Name of Street	Side	Location
Williams Street	North	From Central Street easterly to a point 260 feet east of Central Street

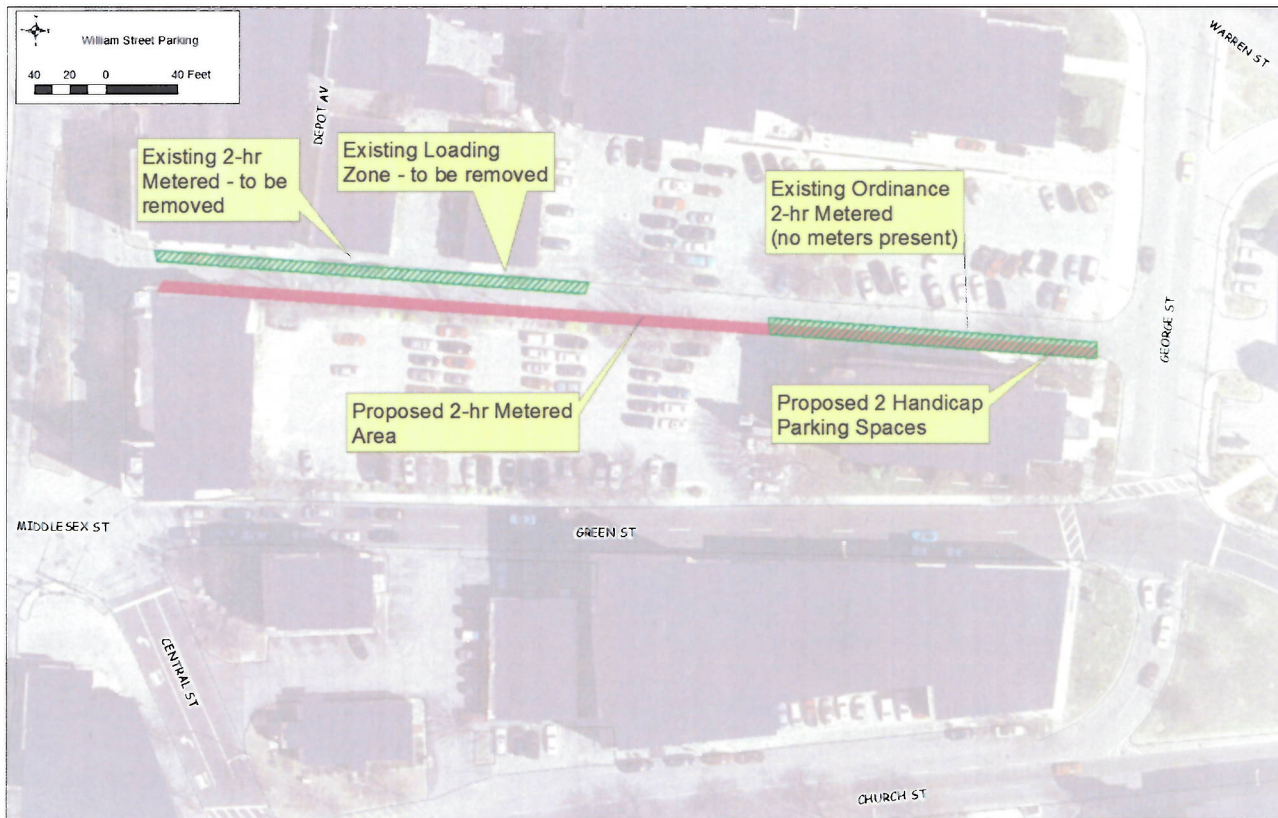

 SUBJECT: PROPOSED 60 DAY TRIAL TRAFFIC ORDERS

Attached are the 60-day trial traffic orders for this week as follows:

- Williams Street Parking – Per request from MCC and office building. Currently ordinances call for metered parking on the north side of Williams Street from Central Street easterly for 260 feet and for metered parking on the south side of Williams Street from George Street westerly for 200 feet. For some reason the meters on the south side are not installed. The Transportation Engineer has received request from both MCC and the owner of the office building at 21 George Street to install metered and handicap parking on the south side of Williams Street. Figure 1 below shows the existing and proposed parking. It is estimated that a net gain of 15 metered parking spaces would be realized for downtown.
- Handicap Parking – Per petition on Lincoln and Moody Streets.
