9.10. Councilor Leahy – Request City Manager work with the Police Department. to enforce no parking on sidewalks.

In the time period from January 1, 2017 /2017 through July 12, 2017, 760 parking citations have been issued for vehicles parked on sidewalks. 575 of these were issued by police officers, and 185 were issued by the Parking Department. The highest numbers of tickets were issued on Bridge Street, Lawrence Street, Middlesex Street, School Street, Hildreth Street, Aiken Street, and Stevens Street. Several of these vehicles were also towed. The fines for the issued tickets totaled \$37,850.

The Lowell Police Department will continue this enforcement activity in an effort to provide safe passage for pedestrians in these areas.
