SUBJECT: MOTION RESPONSE: 8/27/24—C. Belanger—Req. City Mgr. have Parks Dept. landscape and remove dumping materials surrounding the Pyne School as well as consider the installation of cameras and signage to combat further dumping trash and construction materials

The City Manager's Office is working closely with the Parks Department and the School Department to be sure the areas surrounding the Pyne School are cleared of debris. The islands around the school frequently have materials dumped on the property illegally. The School Department and the Parks Department work to make sure the area is clear. About a month ago, the Parks Department removed piles of wood from one of the areas of land near the school. They are in the process of removing a pile of cement, which was also illegally dumped nearby.

The Parks Department often removes illegally dumped materials and continues to do so, as the incidents are reported. In addition, the City has installed "No Dumping" signs in this area to further discourage illegal dumping.
