ORDER

Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period of sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of sixty (60) days thereafter, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

Fifteen minute parking area – A - is hereby amended by adding the following:

Branch Street (56)	South	Beginning at a point 60 feet southwest of the westerly curbline of Smith Street, running southwest along Branch Street for a distance of 20 feet.

§266-55 **Parking for handicapped persons; elderly drop-off zones – C** is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Ames Street (16)	North	Beginning at a point 117 feet northeast from the easterly curbline of Central Street and running northeast along Ames Street a distance of 20 feet.
Loring Street (67-69)	West	Beginning at a point 200 feet north of the of the northerly curbline of Westford Street, running northerly along Loring Street for a distance of 20 feet.

§266-55 **Parking for handicapped persons; elderly drop-off zones – C** is hereby amended by **deleting** the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Linden Street (6)	East	Beginning at a point 20 feet south from the southerly curbline of Union Street and running southerly a distance of 20 feet.
