I am writing in response to the above motion made by C. Elliott. DPW has investigated this request.

Rather than removing these signs and incurring an expense in retaining a crane company to perform this work, DPW/Solid Waste is proposing that City Council repurpose these signs to be used for education and outreach as part of the Solid Waste Recycling Program over the next few years. The City recently received grant funds for this outreach which can be used to have a local sign company place material on these signs.

If this is acceptable to the City Council, DPW/Solid Waste will proceed with this outreach.
