With the construction on Thorndike St ongoing and upcoming Lord overpass issue the more access we have in and out of downtown the better.

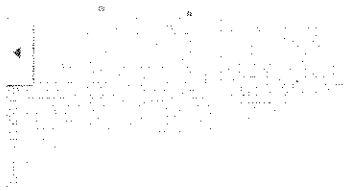
