ORDER

Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period of sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of sixty (60) days thereafter, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

**§266-36**

**Commercial vehicles restricted** – **A** is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

(6) Sparks Street, against both directions of traffic from the first intersection with Martin Street to the second intersection with Martin Street.

**§266-44**

**One-way Streets designated** is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Perry Street

**Location**  
From Sherman Street to Rogers Street

**§266-55**

**Parking for handicapped persons; elderly drop-off zones – C** is hereby amended by **deleting** the following:

Suffolk Street (186)

West

Beginning at a point 55 feet north of the northerly curblines of Dublin Street running northerly a distance of 20 feet along Suffolk Street.

**§266-55**

**Parking for handicapped persons; elderly drop-off zones – C** is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

**Name of Street**

**Side**

**Location**

Broadway  
(186 Suffolk)

South

Beginning at a point 40 feet west of the westerly curblines of Suffolk Street running westerly a distance of 20 feet along Broadway Street.

Liberty Street  
(185 Smith)

South

Beginning at a point 40 feet west of the westerly curblines of Smith Street running westerly a distance of 20 feet along Liberty Street.

Lincoln Street (93)

West

Beginning at a point 214 feet south of the southeasterly curblines of Short Street running southerly a distance of 20 feet along Lincoln Street.

Merrimack Street (15)

North

Beginning at a point 62 feet west of the southwesterly curblines of Bridge Street

running westerly a distance of 20 feet along Merrimack Street.

**§266-56**

**Parking prohibited on certain streets at all times**  
is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Courtney Lane	Both	From Lakeview Avenue to a point 52 feet southwest of Lakeview Avenue.
