Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period of sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of sixty (60) days thereafter, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

§266-36

Commercial vehicles restricted – A is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

(5) Olive Street, against eastbound commercial vehicles from Gorham Street to the end of Olive Street.

(6) Olive Street, against westbound commercial vehicles from the end of Olive Street to Gorham Street

§266-37

Left Turns Restricted – is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Stop intersections – is hereby amended by **adding** the following:
