To whom it may concern,

My name is Eduardo Beato and I was recently involved in an incident where the Lowell Police Department made a mistake and was told to contact you about a request to reimburse.

On October 21st my motorcycle went missing from my home, 1900 Skyline Drive Unit 4, Lowell MA. I called multiple towing companies and then called the Lowell PD. They did not have record of it being towed, so we concluded that the vehicle was stolen and a police officer came by and made a stolen vehicle report. Two weeks later, Saturday Nov 3rd, I received a letter in the mail from a towing company letting me know that they towed my vehicle on October 24th and that it has been in their possession since then.

The problem was that this was the first time I was notified that the vehicle had been recovered. When the tow yard called the PD about the vehicle on Oct 24th, they were never told that it was stolen. If I would have known on the 24th that the vehicle was recovered, I would have picked it up from the tow yard that day. But because the vehicle sat in the tow yard for 12 days, in order for me to pick it up I had to pay a bill of \$1446.54.

I went to the Lowell PD the following Monday, November 5th, to see why I was never called about the vehicle being recovered. After a few hours of waiting at the Lowell PD I was finally told why I was never called. The dispatch unit made a mistake when putting my license plate into their system. So when the tow yard called them and gave them my license plate number, it didn't match my stolen vehicle because they typed it incorrectly into their system.

I spoke with the captain and he let me know that although it was an error on the part of the PD, they could not reimburse me themselves, but instead I could bring the case before the city clerk so that you could reimburse me for the tow of the vehicle.

All of the supporting documents to prove the events described above are included with this letter.
