ORDER

Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period up to sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period up to sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of up to sixty (60) days, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

Fifteen minute parking area – A - is hereby amended by adding the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
-----------------------	-------------	-----------------

Central Street	West	Beginning at a point 20 feet southerly from the southerly curblineline of Charles Street running south for 20 feet.
Charles Street	South	Beginning at a point 20 feet westerly from the westerly curblineline of Central Street running west for 20 feet.
Broadway	South	Beginning at a point 260 feet easterly from the easterly curblineline of Walker Street running east for 20 feet.

Parking for handicapped persons; elderly drop-off zones – C is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Lundberg Street (95)	South	Beginning at a point 61 feet southwest of the westerly curblineline of O’Neil Street running southerly a distance of 20 feet along Lundberg Street.
Fay Street (58, #1)	North	Beginning at a point 574 feet east of the easterly curblineline of Gorham Street running easterly a distance of 20 feet along Fay Street.

One-way Streets Designated is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

SUBJECT: PROPOSED 60 DAY TRIAL TRAFFIC ORDERS

Attached are the 60-day trial traffic orders for this week as follows:

- 15 minute parking – Central and Charles Street per business request. The 15-minute parking signs are already in place on the street for 15-minute parking from 6:00-11:00 pm. Adding the ordinance to include 15-minute parking during the hours of 8:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- 15 minute parking – Broadway per business request. Note that a residential parking only sign will need to be relocated.
- Handicapped Parking – Per petition on Lundberg Street and Fay Street.
- One-way Designation – Suttle Street, per motion. The purpose of the one-way designation is to reduce cut through traffic on a residential street. A letter was sent to all residents requesting feedback.
