
REFERENCE: OVERHANGING SIGN – 170 MERRIMACK STREET

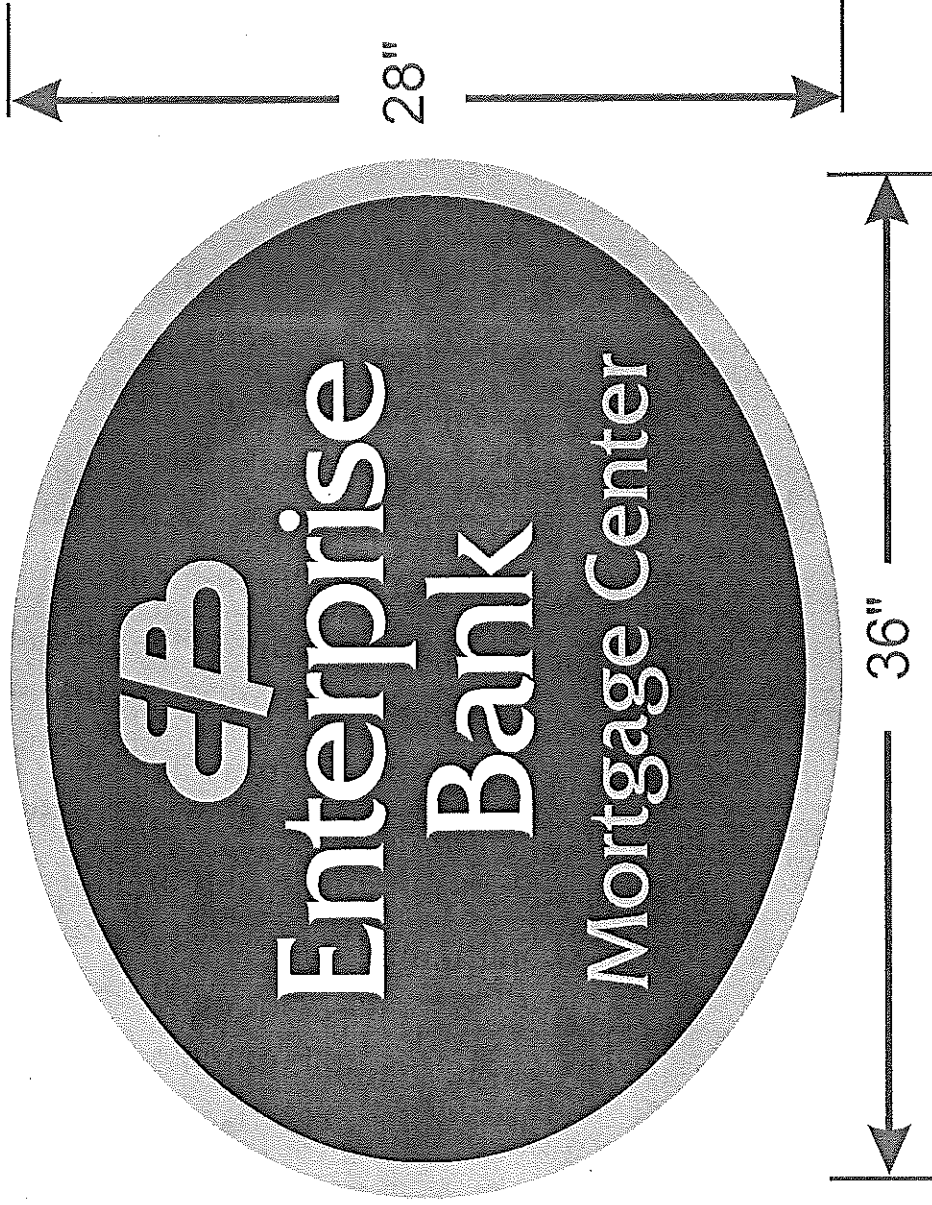
