RE: Council Motion of 1/15/2019 by Councilor Cirillo - "Request City Manager to direct the proper department to replant, in the spring, the cherry blossom trees outside of the Leo Roy Garage."

The City of Lowell's Department of Public Works removed the Cherry Blossom Trees, planted in the Rotunda in front to the Leo Roy garage in the fall of 2018. The tree removal became necessary after it was discovered that said trees were dry and dead.

New Cherry Blossom Trees have been purchased and are scheduled to be planted in spring 2019. The City of Lowell Parking Department in partnership with the Department of Public Works, the Lowell Parks & Conservation Trust, and the City's Department of Planning is in the process of planning additional beautification of the Leo Roy Rotunda in the spring of 2019.
