VOTE

Approving the exemption of Christopher Lemay from the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 268A, section 20.

Christopher Lemay is employed as a Dispatcher with the City of Lowell Police Department; and

Christopher Lemay desires to accept a position with the City of Lowell School Department as a substitute teacher; and

In order to be employed in a second position with the City of Lowell an exemption from the provisions of section 20 of Chapter 268A is required; and

In order to qualify for such exemption an employee must satisfy all of the conditions under said Chapter 268A, section 20; and

The position of a substitute teacher with the Lowell School Department is with a completely independent department; and

The position with the Lowell School Department was publicly advertised; and

Christopher Lemay filed a statement disclosing the second job with the City Clerk; and

The second job will be performed outside the normal working hours of the first position; and

The services to be performed in the Lowell School Department as a substitute teacher are not part of Christopher Lemay's duties in his primary job as a Dispatcher with the City of Lowell Police Department; and

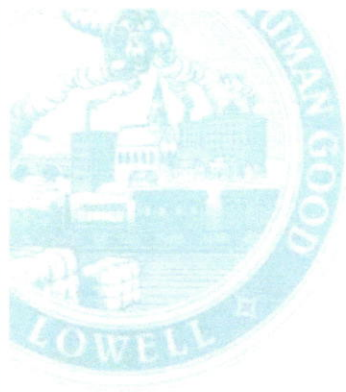
Christopher Lemay will not be compensated in the second position for more than five hundred (500) hours per year; and

The Assistant Superintendent has certified that no employee of that department is available to perform the duties of the substitute teacher for the Lowell School Department.

BE IT VOTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWELL, as follows:

That the City Council of the City of Lowell hereby approves the exemption of Christopher Lemay from the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 268A, section 20.
