Dear Mr. Geary,
Thank you for speaking with me on the phone. My name is Karen Lee and I am an owner at Renaissance on the River, located at 35 Riverwalk Way in Lowell. I am also the Chair of the ROR External Relations Committee and we are currently evaluating resident parking for the Renaissance on the River buildings on Riverwalk Way and Lawrence Drive. I wanted to bring to your attention a matter that I have been discussing with the previous and current parking directors and that is the parking specifically along Riverwalk Way in Lowell.

Most of the residents at ROR have expressed frustrations with the limited amount of parking that we have available and I am looking to see how I can help to expand it. Currently, the parking along Riverwalk Way is only available to residents with stickers Monday thru Friday from 7-10pm. We would like to request that the parking along Riverwalk Way be available exclusively to residents only for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

We are all aware that there are only a handful of spaces available on Riverwalk Way however, I think just by making that adjustment, we could ease some parking tensions exponentially. I know that past and current Parking Directors, Nick Navin and Tobias Marx, have done a lot of work toward this effort already and I wanted to make you aware.
Please let me know if I can provide any more information to help this along. Thank you for your consideration with the City Council.
