RE: EV Charging Stations – Rebate Program Pre-Approval

In April National Grid started to pilot a prescriptive process for its Massachusetts EV Charging Station Program so customers could install Level 2 charging stations with no pre-approval.

The City of Lowell Parking Department in a team effort with DPD's Energy Manager submitted 5 applications to expand our EV Charging Network under that program.

We submitted applications for the following locations:

- City Hall Area – Stretch of Worthen Street for 1 EV Charging Station
- Davidson Surface Lot for 2 EV Charging Stations
- Leo Roy Garage for 4 EV Charging Stations
- George A. Ayotte Garage for 4 EV Charging Stations
- Lower Locks Garage for 4 EV Charging Stations

We have received Pre-Approval from National Grid for all 5 locations and are now coordinating to complete the installation by May 31 to be able to receive the full rebate.

Once the new stations are installed our network will increase from currently 5 EV Charging Stations and 10 charging ports to 20 EV Charging Stations with 40 charging ports.
