3. SPECIAL ORDER OF BUSINESS

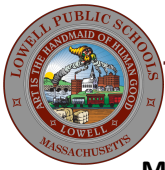

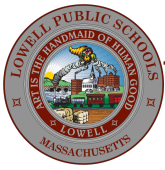
4. EXECUTIVE SESSION
