- [Temporary Outdoor Seating Program](#)
 - If you have an existing license and **do not** wish to expand your outdoor seating area, you do not need to take any action.
 - If you require an amendment to your liquor license, please note that you will need approval from the Lowell License Commission. **Contact Info:** Ryan Wynn, 978-674-153

- **INSPECTIONS:**
 - If your restaurant has been closed for over thirty days, and you have existing food permit, please contact Senior Health Inspector Shawn Machado at 978-674-1458 or smachado@lowellma.gov to schedule a re-inspection prior to re-opening your restaurant. Development Services requires 24 hour notice and will be able to accommodate inspections, Monday – Saturday, 8AM- 5PM
 - If your restaurant has been serving take out, delivery, and/or curbside pickup, periodic inspections from Division of Development Services staff will resume as normal during Phase 2 of Reopening Massachusetts.
