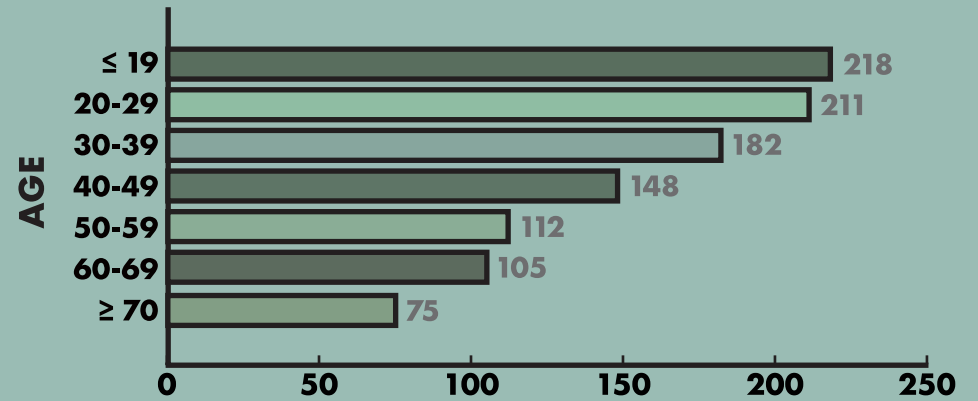

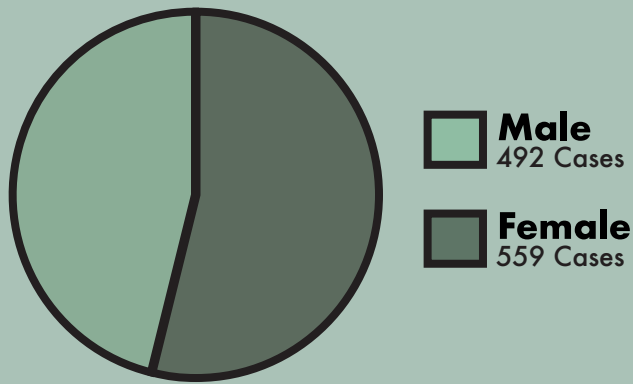

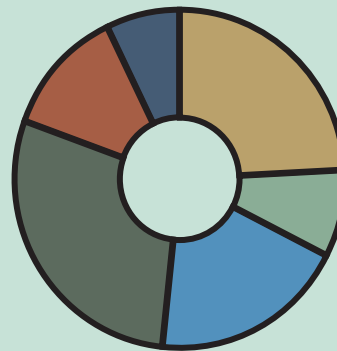
DISTRIBUTION BY AGE
